When connecting the ballast to your current system, you must remove the existing harness from the system and connect the wires from the E-Ballast harness directly to the mogul socket. Be sure to match colors (white to white, green to green, black to black).

The following lamps are **NOT APPROVED**, due the the construction of these lamps:

NOT APPROVED - Sunburst and ALS "12 k - 175, 250, or 400 Watt

Due to lamp deterioration and aging, an older lamp that has previously been run on a standard core and coil ballast may experience lamp flickering. This is due to the stress and premature aging that a core & coil ballast puts on the lamp.

A new lamp that is run on the BlueLine E-Ballast will not flicker throughout the life of the lamp.
